in hand well and truly paid by the said PLANTERS SAVINGS BANK, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PLANTERS SAVINGS BANK.....

all my right, title and interest in and to all that certain parcel and tract of land of which A.W. Gilreath died seized and possessed, located in Highland Township, and O'Neal Township and containing four hundred acres, more or less, and known as the A.W. Gilreath Home Place, and bounded by lands of Robinson, Gilreath and Others, and also sundry lots in the city of Greer, on Hubert Street, and on lots in Greenville Township, more particularly described in deed from various parties to A.W.
