Jordan Road, being the same lot of land deeded to me by J.H. Eagwell in deed bearing date of  
November 15th, 1910 and recorded in office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Vol. 13, page  
329. For a full description of said land reference is hereby expressly made to said deed.
