the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain, piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

About three miles east of the City of Greenville, on the North side of Laurens Road and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin at intersection of Laurens Road and an unnamed Street, and running thence with said Street N. 47-15 E. 200 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 42-35 W. 63.6 feet to iron pin corner of lot No. 1; thence along joint line of lots 1 and 2, S. 45-15 W. 186.6 feet to iron pin on Laurens Road; thence along Laurens Road S. 30-50 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner, being known and designated as lot No. 2 on plat of Jameson-Goodwin property, and the same lot of land conveyed to us by J.W.-Norwood by deed not yet recorded. Said W.C. Coile owning an undivided nine-tenths interest and H.E. Hines an undivided one-tenth interest in said lot of land.
