the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain, piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

In Greenville County, South Carolina, about 2 1/2 miles from the County Court House, fronting on Young Street and being a part of a subdivision of certain lots in what is known as Sane Sene Village, a suburban land company property and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Young Street, 170 feet from the corner of Beadon on Young Street and running thence N. 73 E. 179 feet to a stake thence N. 57-25 W. 46 feet to a stake, 202 feet from the Franking Road, thence S. 19-20 W. 172 feet to a stake on Young Street, thence along Young Street S. 57-25 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner, being the same conveyed to me by William Sheodere by deed dated July 28th 1924, and recorded in the M.
