per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain, piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All That piece or parcel of land situate just beyond the western line of the incorporate limits of the city of Greenville and known as the city vest property, beginning at a stake at the corner of Henderson and Summitt streets and running thence north 30° E. with Henderson street 100 feet to a stake; Thence N. 89 1/2° W. 150 feet to a stake on an alley; Thence with said alley south 0.30 W. 100 feet to a stake on Summitt street; Thence with Summitt street S. 89 1/2° E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, being lots Nos. 65 and 66, according to a plat made by W. A. Adams and recorded on plat Book in the office of R. M. C. of Greenville County.

Being the same lots conveyed to me as Rachel E. Granger, I having since married and am now Rachel E. G. Duncan. See recorded volume 10, page 510.
