bargain, sell and release unto the said *The Peoples National Bank of Greenville*

S.C. that certain tract of land on the old Cox
Bridge Road and waters of Saluda River about
five miles from Greenville Court House, west bounded
as follows: Beginning from 340m in branch Ed
Walls land running 17.20 N. 15 1/2 W. to the rock Old
Log Bridge Road thence 4.65 N. 80 1/2 E. thence to the
604 Bridge Road thence with said Road 5.00 S 49 1/2
E. from 344m in Road thence 12.00 S. 7 1/2 E. to a stone
347m in the branch thence with said branch
to the vacancy containing sixteen acres (16) in
the boundaries the 34 acre in known as the
closed church lot.
