SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said *F. C. Bright*
in and by *A* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

H. P. and C. M. McGeer, Trustees
in the full and just sum of *Fifteen hundred Dollars* (\$1500.00) *Trustees*
Dollars, to be paid *one year from date herof*

with interest thereon, from *July 12th, 1926* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *Semi-annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee *ten per cent*
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said *F. C. Bright*

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *H. P. and C. M. McGeer, Trustees*

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, the said *F. C. Bright*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *H. P. and C. M. McGeer, Trustees*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *H. P. and C. M. McGeer, Trustees* their successors

and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and State of South Carolina and originally containing five hundred & sixty one (561) acres and being the same lands conveyed to me by Caliza M. Miles 2nd Dec. 1912, and more fully described in said Deed recorded in Deed Book 21, page 499, C. M. C. Greenville County South Carolina, being all said tract except 81 acres sold John Thurston, 28 acres Harry Thurston and 38 acres to J. A. Bright, making the amt. now 414 acres more or less.
