computed and paid **annually**
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of **Twenty-five dollars** besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said **W.A. Hopkins, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain**

lot or tract of real estate lying and being situated in Oaklawn Township, State and County aforesaid, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Ananda Davenport by her deed bearing date of January 23rd, 1902, and recorded in R.A.C. Office Greenville County in Vol. LLL at page 588, and formerly conveyed to Ananda Davenport by Hon John C. Bailey, Judge Probate, Greenville County, containing about eighty-four acres, more or less, part of the original tract having been conveyed to A.B. Davenport and others. Land bounded by lands of A.B. Davenport, I.J. Watkins and others.
