in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, an well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Six hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent. of the amount due upon said note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said N. A. Henderson, all that certain tract of land situated in the County

and State aforesaid and in Fairview Township, having the following lines, courses, distances to-wit: Beginning at a stone x in the public road running from Simpsonville by J.B. Wasson Store; thence S. 64.30 E. 33.67 to stone 3x; thence N. 64 10.60 to stone 3x; thence N. 69.45 W. 29.65 to stone in road; thence S. 14.30 6.57 to the beginning corner, containing 24.93 acres, more or less and bounded on the north by lands of O.F. Henderson land sold to P.H. James on the East by land of Stewart Fowler, the south by the Wood Place and on the west by the public road being the tract of land conveyed to me by W.M.
