WHEREAS, I, Mary Frances Moorehead, the said Mary Frances Moorehead
in and by A. certain A. note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Thirty-three hundred

Dollars, to be paid in monthly payments of fifty dollars each
beginning the 5th day of December, 1925. Said payments
to be applied first to the payment of interest and
then to the payment of principal with privilege to anticipate
with interest thereon, from date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,

who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of three percent
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof; the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, refer-
ence being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

bargain, sell and release unto the said Lucy E. Curston

All that one certain lot of land situate in
the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, known
as lot number two (2) in the M. Perry's subdivision
of fourteen acre tract of land on the north
Buncombe Road about two miles north of the
City of Greenville, known as Sans Rancé Park and
having the following lines, courses and distances
to-wit:

Beginning at stake on eastern edge of Perry
Road, one hundred fifty (150) feet from Buncombe
Road, thence S. 44-26 E. one hundred sixty-nine
(169) feet to stake, thence N. 33-51 E. Seventy-nine
feet (79) to stake, thence N. 74-26 W. one hundred
ninety-five (195) feet to stake on eastern edge
of Perry Road, thence along the eastern edge
