SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *C. B. Jones*  
in and by *my* certain *(Promissory)* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*J. W. Norwood*  
in the full and just sum of *Eight hundred and no/100 dollars (\$800.00)*  
Dollars, to be paid *On or before three years after Date*

with interest thereon, from *Date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,  
who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

*ten per cent* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note. *THE DEBT HEREBY FULLY AND THE ENTIRETY OF THIS INSTRUMENT IS SATISFIED.* *12th DAY*  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, refer-  
ence being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *October 7*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of *money* for said *and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said*  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of *Dollars*, to

*C. B. Jones* the said *Deputy R. M. C.*  
in hand well and truly paid by the said *J. W. Norwood*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, *12 5/11* granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. W. Norwood, his heirs and assigns.*

All that certain tract of land in Butler Township, State and County aforesaid, containing  
twenty-two (22) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds as set out  
in a plat made by A.S. Redell, Surveyor, September 5, 1914, recorded in R.M.C. Office for  
Greenville County in Plat Book D, at page 39: Beginning at a point on the line of W.M.-  
Stenhouse, the northern boundary of said property, and running thence S. 26-1/2 E. 17.89  
to iron pin; thence N. 74-3/4 E. 13.65 to iron pin; thence N. 25-1/4 W. 17.15 to stake;  
thence N. 77-2/3 W. 14.25 to the beginning corner. Being the same lot of land conveyed by  
J.T. Spearman to Julius Newton by deed dated March 3, 1924, recorded in R.M.C. Office for  
Greenville County in Vol. 118 at page 140, and conveyed to me by Julius Newton by deed  
dated November 12, 1925, not yet recorded.  
This mortgage is given to secure the balance of purchase price.
