*I, L. W. Young of Greenville County State of South Carolina*

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *2*, the said *L. W. Young*  
in and by *a* certain *promissory* note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

*Jackson Company*  
in the full and just sum of *Six hundred and fifty (\$650.00) dollars*  
Dollars, to be paid *November 15th, 1926*

with interest thereon, from *maturity* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid *Annually*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof,

who may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *10% on amount so*  
*Collected* besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or  
any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, refer-  
ence being thereunto, will more fully appear.)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN That *I* the said *L. W. Young*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Jackson Company*

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me*, the said *L. W.*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Jackson Company*

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release of the said *Jackson Company* all that certain piece parcel

or tract of land lying, being and situate in the County and state  
aforesaid. The same being a part of a tract of land conveyed to  
Ancrum Fuller by the deed of J. T. West on the first day January  
1910, and recorded in office of R. M. C. for Greenville County on the  
16th day of February 1910 in Book 3 of deeds at page 279 and  
being more fully described as follows: Beginning at stone on  
road thence N. W. 1200 to a stone, thence S. 20 W. 13.00 to a stone,  
thence due west 1300 to a stone, thence S. 21 1/2 E. 15.90 to a stone  
on Georgia Road, thence N. 76 E. 206 to a stone, thence N. 78 1/2 E. 906  
to a stone, thence S. 85 E. 220 to a stone thence N. 23 E. 10.00 to a  
pine, thence N. 20 1/2 E. 20 to the beginning corner.  
Containing forty-four and three quarters acres (44 3/4) more or less  
and bounded by lands of E. B. Garrison, B. B. Young, Ancrum  
Fuller and J. W. Brown. Being the same tract of land conveyed  
to me by Ancrum Fuller by deed dated February 22nd 1918 and  
recorded in R. M. C. office at Greenville Court House, Greenville,  
S. C. April 13th, 1918 in vol. 35 at page 227.
