Road and to the North of the last mentioned Road, containing fifteen and 70/100 (15.70)
acres, more or less and being part of a tract of 23.70 acres conveyed to me by C.G. Snead
by deed dated September 2, 1919 and recorded in Vol. 57, page 5, R.M.C. Records for
Greenville County and this mortgage is intended to cover all of said tract of 23.70 acres

March 25th, 1926, to be recorded, it being understood and agreed that fifteen feet is
