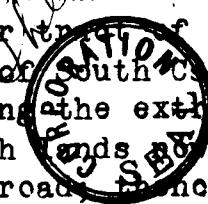

All of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land lying, being and situate in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point marking the extreme Northeastern corner of the within described tract, which point marks corner with lands or formerly owned by F.S. Peden and which point is in the center of a public road, thence along line of said Peden S. 17° E. the line running for a part of the way along the center of said Public Road, 43.44 chs. to a stake, marking corner with lands now or formerly owned by S.A. Fowler and J.B. Wasson; thence along said line of Wasson S. 80-1/4° W. 27.28 chs. to a stake; thence N. 1-1/4° E. crossing branch 21.50 chs. to a stake; thence N. 87-1/4° W. 6.00 chs. to a stake; thence N. 5° W. 18.00 chs. to a stake; thence N. 68° E. 14.50 chs. to a stake; thence S. 1-1/2° W. 1.50 chs. to a stake; thence S. 88-1/2° E. 9.40 chs. to the point and place of beginning; said tract containing 103 acres, according to survey made by James A. Adams, Surveyor, under date of Feb. 1922, and being the same property conveyed to the said S.A. Fowler from W.M. Weaver, by deed dated Jan. 18, 1918, and recorded in D.E. 42, at page 257, in the Clerk's Office for Greenville County, South Carolina.
