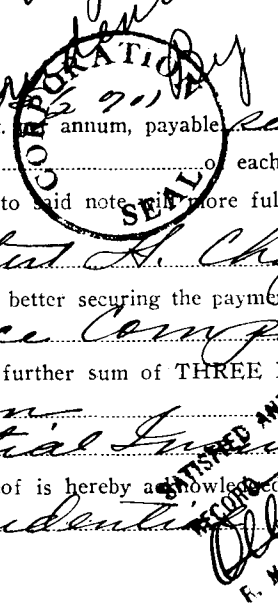

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, on the South side of Washington Place, and being known and designated as Lot No. 2 of the J. W. Norwood property, part of which is recorded in Plat Book C, page 283 and having, according to a plat thereof prepared by J. C. Sirenie & Company, June 1st, 1921, the following lines and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the South side of Washington Place, said pin being 210 feet in a South-westerly direction from Washington Road, and running thence S. 12° 31' E. 131 feet to an iron pin on the North side of a fifteen foot alley; thence with the North side of said alley, S. 51° 57' W. 66 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10° 00' W. 151 feet to an iron pin on the South side of Washington Place, which pin is 309 feet from the East side of McDaniel Avenue; thence with the South side of Washington Place N. 49° 07' E. 60 feet to the point of beginning.
