

THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, George W. Parker of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, I, the said George W. Parker in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 29th day of June 1926

I am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate, duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Seven hundred & no. 00 (\$700.00) Dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 29th day of June A. D. 1926, according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that

the said George W. Parker shall pay or cause to be paid to the said Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of July 1926, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of \$11.67

Dollars, (\$7.00) Dollars, being the regular monthly installment payable on the Seven (7) Shares of Stock, and \$4.67

Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$10.73 Dollars, (\$7.00

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$3.73 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months the sum of \$9.80 Dollars, (\$7.00

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$2.80 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$8.87

Dollars, (\$7.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$1.87 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the

sum of \$9.93 Dollars, (\$7.00) Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$2.93 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)

Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Seven (7) shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made. I, the said

George W. Parker and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against, I, the said George W. Parker

in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said George W. Parker in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me

the said George W. Parker in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing hereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and bounded as follows:

And, witness the City of Greenville, having Allie following metes and bounds, to wit: - Beginning at a stake on East Main Street and running thence with No. 22 Street thence S. 74.44 feet to a pin, thence 77 1/2 E. 157 feet to a stake, thence N. 71 W. 44 feet to a stake; thence S. 117 1/2 W. 158 feet to the beginning corner, and known as lot No. 4 of the Leister property on north side of East Main Street, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Marie S. Conyers by deed dated September 1st, 1911, and recorded in Deed Book 10, Page 351, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

For value received the Carolina Loan Trust Company hereby assigns, transfers and sets over unto J. A. McHugh's Estate the within mortgage and the note it secures without recourse this 31st day of March 1936.
