TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That I, Mrs. R. L. Lindsey of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina send Greeting:

do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:
