in hand, well and truly paid by the said Citizens Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said J. L. Holland

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Citizen Building and Loan Association, of Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, all that lot of land, in said State and County, in the City of Greer, on the west side of Miller Street.

Having the following meter and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron stake, Mayfield's corner at intersection of Church and Miller Streets and running thence with said Church Street 121 feet to Bernice Brockman's corner (now property of Victor-Monaghan Co.); thence with Brockman's line 20 feet to iron stake on M. L. Smith's line; thence with M. L. Smith's line 111 feet to center of Miller Street; thence with Miller Street 210 feet to the beginning corner, containing one-half (1/2) acre, more or less.
