Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Known as lot No. 8 in Hext M. Perry's sub-division of a 14 acre tract of land on the Buncombe Road about two miles North of the City of Greenville, known as Sans Souci Park as per plat recorded in Plat Book "C", page 158 and described as follows: Beginning at stake on the Eastern edge of Perry Road 416 feet from the Southeastern intersection of McCall Street and said road, and runs thence with said Perry Road S. 17.45 W. 65 feet, thence with said road S. 14.50 W. 5.66 feet to a stake; thence S. 74.26 E. 210 feet to a stake; thence N. 17.45 E. 130 feet to a stake; thence N. 74.26 W. 210 feet to the beginning corner.
