WITNESSETH, Whereas the said party of the first part is indebted to said MECHANICS BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION in the sum of

Dollars, money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum, payable weekly,

the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville County of Greenville, And State of Ward 10 Beginning at the corner of Westfield and Hyde streets And running thence with Westfield street, S. $19\frac{3}{4}$ W. 60 feet to the corner of lot known as lot #1 in the subdivision of the Sloan property and now owned by Kate Hyde Sloan, thence with line of last mentioned lot, N. $70\frac{3}{4}$ W. 173 feet, thence N. $19\frac{3}{4}$ E. 60 feet to Hyde street thence with Hyde street to the beginning corner known as a portion of lot #2 in the subdivision of the real estate of the late Curran W. Sloan, And being a part of the lot conveyed to Curran W. Sloan by Kate W. Sloan, et al. by deed dated the 29th day of July 1903 and recorded in Vol. J J. page 680. R. M. C.
