the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, as follows, to-wit:

Just outside of the city limits of the city of Greenville, and designated and known as David Street extension, and described to me as being near David Street in the western portion of the city of Greenville, South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit,

Beginning at a stake on right of way of the old Laurens Railroad, one hundred and twenty seven (127) feet from said David Street and in a northwesterly direction from same, and running thence S. 23 1/2 E. 77.9 feet to stake on a 5 foot alley, thence along said 5 foot alley N. 67 E. 60 feet to stake, thence N. 23 1/2 W. 61.4 feet to the right of way of Laurens Railroad, thence S. 82 W. 63 feet along right of way to the beginning corner.
