per cent. per annum, payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure.

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does want, bargain, sell and release unto the said party of the second part a certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County in the State aforesaid, as follows to-wit:
