 Dollars, to be paid *six months after date*.

with interest thereon, from *date* *July 21st 1926* at the rate of *7* per cent. per annum, to be
 computed and paid *semi annually in advance*.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
 interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *ten per cent*.

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
 added to the amount due on said note..... to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, of said debt, or any
 part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
 being thereunto had as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
 bargain, sell and release unto the said *Wilmingtton Savings & Trust Company* *dated 14 Sept 1926*,

all that piece or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and
 being on the south side of Lloyd Street in the City
 of Greenville, being known and designated as lot #4
 on the east of property of Fred Sumner and having
 the following described bounds, to wit: Beginning at
 an iron pin on an 8-foot alley, 169 feet 6 inches
 from the corner of Beaufort and Lloyd Streets, and
 running thence with Lloyd Street S. 55-+ W. 50
 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lot 4 and 5, thence
 with line of lot #5 N. 37-10 W. 185 feet to an iron pin
 whence N. 54-15 E. 350 feet to an iron pin on line
