may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *\$100.00* (all of which is secured by this mortgage; as it and by the said note, reference

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Susie H. Gloner*

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in
Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of
South Carolina, in the city of Greenville,
on the south side of East Stone Avenue,
and having, according to a plat thereof pre-
pared by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engr., January 14,
1926, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south
side of Stone Avenue, said pin being 186 feet
from Vannoy Street, and running thence S.
20-19 W. 175 feet to an iron pin; thence N.
71-20 W. 62 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 20-
