in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Clarence Castles
in the full and just sum of One hundred eight (108) Dollars and 75 Cents
Dollars, to be paid. One fourth equal quarterly installments of twenty
seven (27) Dollars each, the first installment due on the 1st day of
December 1926; the second installment due on the 1st day of
March 1927; the third installment due on the 1st day of June 1927; and the fourth
with interest thereon, from the date of the first installment at the rate of 8% per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid.

Until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per centum
besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

in consideration of the sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Clarence

Castles, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Clarence Castles, his heirs and assigns

all that piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville
Township, Greenville, S. C., on the South side of Highlawn
Avenue near the Cedar Lane road, fronting said Avenue
71.8 feet, and has a depth in parallel lines of 137.62
feet and known and designated as lot no. 9 in the
subdivision of the G. J. Douglas land, as shown by
plat recorded in plat Book 3. at page 126.
