SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said J. M. Bailey, Jr., in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Miss Jessie Lena Craig, in the full and just sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00)

Dollars, to be paid one half thereof in one year after date and the other one half two years after date

with interest thereon, from March 31, 1926, at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually,

until paid in full; all interest to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said further providing for an attorney's fee of reasonable amount

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collected as a part hereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Miss Jessie Lena Craig, her heirs and assigns

forever, all that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land, lying situate and being in City of Greenville, on East Avenue, in State and County aforesaid, and being known and designated as lot No. 20, according to plat of Endala B. and Elizabeth Jones property, recorded in office of Register of Deeds Conveyances for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "E" at pages 37 and 38, and having a frontage on the South side of East Avenue of sixty-four (64) feet and running back in parallel lines, the West line being one hundred Ninety four (194) feet, and the East line one hundred Ninety and one-half (190.5) feet, and adjoining the property now or formerly owned by Mark Leboine on the East and Mrs. Steel on the West, and being the same lot Conveyed to me this day by said Miss Jessie Lena Craig, and this Mortgage is given to secure a portion of the purchase price thereof.
