I, Lewis Sullivan, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Lewis Sullivan, in and by my certain Promissory Note, even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

Ed. L. Burdette, Jr. in the full and just sum of One Hundred and no (\$100.00) Dollars, to be paid On the 1st day of December A.D. 1926.

with interest thereon, from maturity, at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid Semi-Monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

\$50.00 besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Lewis Sullivan, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Ed. L. Burdette

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Lewis Sullivan

in hand well and truly paid by the said Ed. L. Burdette

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Ed. L. Burdette, his heirs and assigns forever:
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated, lying and being in a settlement known as Stradleyville, on Bob Street, near the city limits of the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, having a frontage of 46 feet on the West side of said Street, and running back in parallel lines along the line of Molly Simpson a depth of 160 1/2 feet, more or less, in a Westwesterly direction, the back line being 46 feet, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by J. W. Williams by deed dated March 29th, 1919, which deed is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book Vol. 34 at Page 519.
