undivided interest in my mother's place the late Mrs. Sallie Slightly, lying and being in county and State aforesaid on the South side of the Pelham road near Round Hill, joined by lands of S. Forrest and William Clady and the Adams Peach Orchard, containing 5 acres or less.

This loan is made with the understanding that there is a mortgage on the place for \$1,000.00 and the interest has been kept paid on said mortgage. Also, all outstanding debts have been paid. This note and mortgage is given as additional security for balance due \$85.00 including interest and cost on note and mortgage given me February 16 1923 for buggy and harness and \$45.00 cash making total amount of this note \$125.00.
