WHEREAS, *Frank Wilson*, the said *Frank Wilson*

with interest thereon, from *July 1st 1927* the rate of *5* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *Frank Wilson*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Twenty cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Frank Wilson*

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said *Frank Wilson*

in hand well and truly paid by the said *Frank Wilson*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *Frank Wilson*

*County, in that certain parcel and lot of land situated
more or less in the County of Greenville, State of South Caro-
lina on Bernie Street in the City of Greenville containing
one-fourth of an acre more or less, being the same lot of
land conveyed to Israel Chapel Church through the Trustees
 thereof by S. M. Sower by deed dated Jan 27 1898 and recorded in
 H. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 107 at page 748 and
 therein described by metes and bounds, courses and distances, as
 follows: Beginning at a stake on north side of Bernie Street,
 being corner and running thence N. 27 1/2 E. 3.25 with the line
 line to a stake, 34; thence N. 82 1/2 W. 75 links to a stake on Williams
 lot; thence with Williams line S. 27 1/2 W. 3.25 to a stake 37 and
 Bernie Street; thence with Bernie Street S. 82 1/2 E. 75 links to
 the beginning corner; being the same lot of land conveyed to the
 said S. M. Sower by deed as aforesaid and recorded in H. M. C.
 Office in Book 17 at page 276; and being the same lot of
 land conveyed to Hunter-Wilson Lumber Company by the said
 Israel Chapel Church through its Trustees by deed recorded
