part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear)

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that I, the said **W.J. Goudelock**

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to **me**, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said **Bank**

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said **Citizens Bank of Taylors**, All that piece or lot of land situated

and lying and being in said State and County, Chick Springs Township, in the Town of  
Taylors, and on the National Highway, adjoining lands of G.W. Hill, M.E. Hudson: Beginning  
on the said National Highway at the said G.W. Hills corner and running along the said  
Highway 100 feet to a stake; thence S. 30 E. 285 feet to the right of way of the Southern  
Railway; thence along the said right-of-way 100 feet to an iron pin to the said G.W.Hills  
corner; thence N. 30 W. 244 feet to the beginning corner together with the right to use  
that portion of the said right-of-way of the said Southern Railroad lying between the above  
described lot and the tracts of the said Southern Railroad as long as the Southern Railroad  
does not use it for railroad purposes. Known as Lots Nos. 19 and 20 on a plat of W.A.Adams,  
dated April 22nd, 1913 and recorded in Plat Book C, page 74.

Also all that piece or lot of land situated in said State and County, Chick Springs  
Township and the Town of Taylors, on the South side of the National Highway joining lands of  
the said J.E. Bishop, G.W. Hill, W.P. Hill, lying between the property of the said J.E.Bishop  
and the said National Highway having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on an iron  
pin, the said G.W. Hill corner on the edge of the National Highway running thence with the  
said G.W. Hill line 77 feet to a stake; thence along the front of lots 19 and 20, 100 feet to  
an iron pin on the said W.P. Raines corner; thence 43 feet to the said National Highway at  
an iron pin; thence along the said National Highway about 100 feet to the beginning corner,  
containing about 1/7 of an acre more or less.
