bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. M. M. & J. Ellison, their heirs and executors,

all my undivided interest in and to all that certain piece
parcel or tract of land in the state and county aforesaid
land in above Township containing thirty (30) acres more
or less and bounded by lands of J. E. McDavid on the
Southwest, J. O. Middleton on the East, Frank Rodgers
on the North and Joe A. Ellison on the West and being
about 12 miles from the Greenville County Court House, on
the West side of Augusta Road. This being the un-
divided interest conveyed to me by F. L. Rodgers by
said dated 20th day of February 1918, and recorded in
the R. I. R. C. office for Greenville County, in vol. 42 at
page 216; also the undivided interest anticipated by me
from the estate of my wife, Mary E. Jenkins, who died
testate on the 9th day of May, 1926, leaving as her sole
issue, at law and distribution the aforesaid, to mortgagor
