*Ten per cent* besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

bargain, sell and release unto the said *Minnie Jumbly*, all of that

*vacant lot inherited from my fathers estate*  
*R. B. Holland being 33 1/2 ft wide on Main*  
*Street and running 150 ft deep adjoining J. E.*  
*Jones on south side and lot once owned by*  
*My sister Blanche Holland Starns.*
