Beginning near a row in with the M^r. Millan corner on the
Chastain branch running thence S. 60 E. 23.50 to the Lindsay
and M^r. Millan Stony corner, thence N. 2.46. 14.50 to an iron
pin on the river bank, thence up the South Fork of Syper
River about 19.70 chains to the mouth of the Chastain branch,
thence up a said branch to the beginning corner, joined
by lands of James W. Lindsay, M^r. Millan and others, and
