Rogers, December 1916, and running S. 28° W. 5.50 Chains to a Poplar on branch; thence S. 65½ W. 5.86 Chains to a small bridge on branch; thence S. 73 W. 4.27 Chains to head in branch; thence S. 83 W. 3.00 Chains to the river; thence down the river 29.20 Chains to a stake; thence N. 80 E. 14.00 Chains to an oak; thence S. 64 E. 16.70 Chains to a stone; thence N. 25¾ W. 25.25 Chains to a stone; thence N. 7½ W. 8.00 Chains to a stone in old river road; thence with said road S. 66 1/4 W. 9.47 Chains to a stone; thence N. 38 1/2 W. 11.70 Chains to the beginning corner, containing sixty-nine 33/100 (69.33) acres, more or less, and shown on said plat as Tracts nos. 9 and 10, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Cedar Falls Light & Power Company by deed bearing date of the 31st day of December, 1917, and recorded in the Office of Register Deed Conveyance in and for Greenville County in vol. 25, at page 234.
