until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

One hundred dollars besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

bargain, sell and release unto the said Dr. A. White, his heirs and assigns forever: All that certain

piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
County of Greenville, on the White Horse Road, near Welcome Church, containing 12 acres,
more or less, known as Tract No. 16 on plat recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for
said County and State in Plat Book "A", at page 165, and having, according to said plat
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake 3xom on the White Horse Road, and running thence with said road
N. 39 W. 10.15 chains to a stone on said road, on the corner of Welcome Church property;
thence along the Staunton Bridge Road approximately S. 15-1/2 W. about 17.77 chains to a
stone 3xom on last mentioned road; thence along Mrs. Hughes line S. 65 E. 8.26 chains
to a stone 3xom on Mrs. Charles line; thence along her line N. 25 E. 13.28 chains to
the beginning corner.
