 or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of One percent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
 added to the amount due on said note..... to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any  
 part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note....., reference

 bargain, sell and release unto the said Salyde Hart,

 just without the City limits of Greenville, near the  
 Rutherford Road, and King Brown and designated as  
 the rear portion of lots Nos. 15, 16, 17 and 18 in Woodside  
 Circle, a subdivision of the Thos. J. Woodside Heirs  
 property, according to a plat recorded in plat book "E"  
 at page 219, said lot having a frontage of fifty  
 (50) feet on North Woodside Circle, and a depth  
 in parallel lines of one hundred (100) feet and  
 adjoining lots 14 and 85, being the same lot of land
