If the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note....., reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

All that piece, parcel or tract, of land in the County and State aforesaid, about three miles from Greenville Court house, containing 9-1/100 acres more or less, Beginning at a stake on old line and running thence S. 18 1/2 W. 11.58 chs. to Stake 2 on or near Reedy River; thence down and with the meanderings of said river 8.00 chains to stake 3 on; thence N. 88 1/2 E. 11.85 chs. to stake; thence N. 5 3/4 E. 8.00 chs. to the beginning corner, being the same lands conveyed to me by deed dated March 30th, 1927, by M. J. Eddings, said deed to be recorded.
