WHEREAS, I, the said E.M. Gillespie

in the full and just sum of Two thousand and no/100 (\$2000.00)

Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon, from date (October 5th, 1926) at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal  
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who  
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent. (10%)

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be  
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt, or any  
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference  
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,

bargain, sell and release unto the said Miss Helen Ragsdale, all that tract of land in Saluda Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Buncombe Road and having the following  
metes and bounds according to a survey made by W.A. Hester, Surveyor: Beginning at a pin  
on the North Saluda River at the mouth of a branch, thence with said branch N. 11 W. four  
(4) chains to a pin; thence along said branch N. 5 1/2 W. 6.50 chains to an iron pin; thence  
N. 33-1/2 W. 37 chains to a stone; thence S. 75 W. 11.75 chains to a chestnut oak; thence S. 32  
W.15 chains to a stake; thence S. 35 W. 5.10 chains to a stake on top of ridge; thence  
S. 38-1/2 E. 12.66 chains to a stake; thence N. 5-1/2 E. 6 chains to a stake; thence S. 38-1/2 E.  
16.75 chains to a stake in road; thence with said road S. 52 W. 6 chains to an iron pin;  
thence S. 38-1/2 E. seven (7) chains to a stake on North Saluda River; thence with said river  
22.74 chains to the initial corner; containing One hundred and five (105) acres, more or  
less; being the same tract of land conveyed to D.M. Levi by Ida Ward, by deed dated November
