See those two certain Pieces, Parcels or lots of land situate, lying  
 and being on the North side of Club Drive, Greenville Township,  
 Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and  
 designated as Lots No. 42 & 43 on Plat of Property of *Anderson* made by *R. E. Dalton, Engineer*, March 1923, and having  
 according to said Plat the following Mates and Bounder to wit.  
 Beginning at an iron Pin on the North side of Club Drive Corn  
 of Lot No. 41 & 42, and running thence N. 18-21 W. 108.5 feet to an  
 iron Pin; thence N. 64-29 E. 153. feet to an iron Pin; thence S. 20-08  
 E. 170.5 feet to an iron Pin on the North side of Club Drive; thence  
 with said Club Drive S. 65-30 W. 157.86 feet to the beginning corner.
