SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *C. W. Hannah*
in and by *one* certain *promissory* note in writing, of
even date with these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to

A. Reid Wood
in the full and just sum of *nine hundred*

Dollars, to be paid *on or before November sixth 1931*

one fifth of the principal and the interest on the
whole debt is to become due and payable on the
sixth day of each November following the date of this
mortgage with interest thereon from *date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum, to be

computed and paid *annually on the sixth day of each Nov.*

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal
or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who
may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *three per cent*

besides all costs and expenses of collection to be
added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any
part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference
being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said *A. Reid Wood*, all that certain piece parcel

County, and state aforesaid, in Oreal township, being a
portion of tract no 15 of the Real Estate of Washington
Taylor deceased, adjoining lands of the estate of William
Bibson and *J. N. Nesbitt*. Beginning at a stone of

83 chs. to stone on tract no 10, of Washington Taylor
Estate thence N. 2 1/2 E. 15 chs. to a corner on bank of
