part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note....., reference

all that *one* parcel of lot of land situate in Ward
One in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
beginning at a stake on the corner of lot No. 3
and running thence easterly fifty feet to corner of
lot No. 5; thence North 106.77 feet to a pin on corner
of lot No. 5 adjoining McCaulley's property; thence
westerly 50 feet to pin, on corner of lot No. 4 and
McCaulley's property; thence south 107.6 feet to the
beginning corner on Hanley Street this being known
as lot No. 4 of sub-division of W. M. Jordan, F. H.
and J. G. Cunningham recorded June 29th, 1921 at
