PARCEL No. 2—BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southwest corner of a 0.34 acre tract of land acquired by Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation by Deed dated August 25, 1951 and recorded in Deed Book 518, page 451, Gaston County, North Carolina; THENCE S 55° 39' E a distance of 125 feet to an iron pin at the southeast corner of said 0.34 acre tract; THENCE S 34° 21' W a distance of 60 feet to a point; THENCE N 55° 39' W a distance of 107.35 feet to a point on the boundary line between lands now or formerly of Christy Jenkins Estate and Roy Rhyne on the west; THENCE N 18° 00' E a distance of 62.54 feet to the place of BEGINNING and containing 0.16 acre of land, more or less.
