FIRST

PIPE LINES

All of the following described pipe lines for the transportation and supply of natural gas acquired or constructed by the Company and not heretofore specifically described in the granting clauses of the Indenture, and all real estate and rights-of-way acquired by the Company pertaining to said pipe lines or used or useful in the operation thereof:

MAIN LINE AND MAIN LINE LOOPS

Louisiana

Two 36-inch main line loop sections in Louisiana, totaling approximately 21.59 miles in length described as follows:

- (a) One 36-inch Main Line Loop "C" section approximately 12.57 miles in length, beginning at a point approximately 294 feet west of main line valve 50C10, located in Section 107, T-5-S, R-3-E, and continuing in an easterly direction to the tie-in to the existing loop line at main line valve 50C20, located in Section 33, T-4-S, R-5-E, all in St. Landry Parish, Louisiana. Included in this loop section is a main line valve with crossovers to Lines "A" and "B" at the beginning of the spread.
- (b) One 36-inch Main Line Loop "C" section approximately 9.02 miles in length, beginning at main line valve 60C20, M.P. 618.20 located in Section 44, T-1-S, R-4-E, and continues in an easterly direction to the Louisiana-Mississippi State Line, all in St. Helena Parish, Louisiana. Included in this loop section is a main line valve with double crossover to main line "A" at the beginning of the loop, two main line valves and scraper trap assemblies with tie-ins to the suction and discharge lines at Compressor Station 65.

MISSISSIPPI

Two 36-inch main line loop sections in Mississippi, totaling approximately 11.45 miles in length described as follows:

(a) One 36-inch Main Line Loop "C" section approximately 5.69 miles in length, beginning at the Louisiana-Mississippi State Line and continuing in an easterly direction to the end of the loop section at Milepost 632.88, located in Section 21, T-1-N, R-6-E, all in Amite County, Mississippi. Included in this loop section is a main line valve with
