C., according to the condition of the said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to me the said Anne M. Moore

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST NATIONAL BANK of Greenville, S. C., and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and, by these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST NATIONAL BANK of Greenville, S. C., all that tract or parcel of land, situated in County of Greenville State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

In the City of Greenville, being known and designated as part of lot #11 on plat of property of Mrs. Anne M. Moore, recorded in the R. M. C. Office of Greenville County, in Deed Book 16, page 179, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin at the north west corner of Augusta Street and Mills Avenue, and thence along the western side of Augusta Street N. 29.55 26.2073 feet to an iron pin at the south-east corner of Augusta Street and Otis Street; thence along southern side of Otis Street S. 71.35 213 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18.6. 143.1 feet to an iron pin; thence in a straight line approximately 135 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Mills Avenue; thence along the northern side of Mills Avenue N. 53.57 E. 226 feet to the beginning corner, being part of the land conveyed to me by O. P. Mills by deed dated February 2, 1901, recorded in Office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book III, page 289.
