All that certain lot of land situate on the East side of Green Avenue in the city of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at an iron stake on the East side of Green Avenue corner of lot of J. E. Stokes, formerly of Emma N. Watson, being one hundred and three and one-half (103 1/2) feet from the North-East corner of Green Avenue and Harlington Street, and running thence with Green Avenue N. 26 E. one hundred and three and one-half (103 1/2) feet to an iron Pin, corner of lot of J. N. Mahon, being two hundred and eight and one-half (208 1/2) feet from the South-East corner of Yardley Street and Green Avenue; thence with line of said Mahon lot S. 71 3/4 E. one hundred and fifty (150) feet to an iron Pin; thence S. 28 W. one hundred and three and one-half (103 1/2) feet to an iron Pin, corner of lot of J.
