securing the payment thereof, the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, according to the condition of the said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of FIVE DOLLARS, to me the said L. S. Campbell

in hand well and truly paid by the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and these presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said PIEDMONT SAVINGS AND TRUST COMPANY, all the tract or parcel of land situated in County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Piedmont Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Greenville Street, corner of A. L. Simpson's property; thence in a south westerly direction in line of said Simpson property, 21 1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence still, with line of Simpson property in a south easterly direction, 100 feet to an iron pin; thence in a north easterly direction, with line of property of Sula H. Simpson, 215 feet, more or less, to iron pin on the south side of Greenville Street, which iron pin is 110 feet east from the point of beginning; thence along the south side of Greenville Street in a north westerly direction 110 feet to the point of beginning.
