Beginning at a point in the westerly line of Route 206, said point bears North twenty degrees forty-six minutes fifty seconds East (N 20° 46′ 50″ E) two hundred ninety-nine and fifty-seven hundredths (299.57) feet from the point of intersection of the said line with the northerly line of Hilltop Drive, fifty (50) feet in width, and running; thence (1) along lands of Transcontinental Gas Pipe Line Corporation, North eighty-three degrees sixteen minutes forty seconds West (N 83° 16' 40" W) two hundred sixty-nine and thirty-eight hundredths (269.38) feet to a point; thence (2) along lands now or formerly of Marshall Clagett et ux, North four degrees thirty-eight minutes twenty seconds East (N 04° 38′ 20″ E) two hundred twenty and five hundredths (220.05) feet to a point; thence (3) along other lands of Edwin L. Kimble et ux. South eighty-three degrees sixteen minutes forty seconds East (S 83° 16' 40" E) three hundred nineteen and twenty-eight hundredths (319.28) feet to a point; thence (4) along the aforesaid westerly line of Route 206, along a curve bearing to the right in a southerly direction with a radius of one thousand four hundred sixteen and twenty hundredths (1416.20) feet, a distance of one hundred ninety and thirty-five hundredths (190.35) feet to a point of tangency; thence (5) South twenty degrees forty-six minutes fifty seconds West (S 20° 46′ 50" W) thirty-three and seventy-two hundredths (33.72) feet to the point and place of Beginning. Containing 1.500 acres.

Subject to a ten (10) feet wide easement for utilities along the entire length of courses numbered four (4) and five (5) above.

Also subject to a twenty (20) feet wide easement for utilities, the centerline of which is described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the westerly line of U. S. #206, said point bears four hundred and thirty-eight (438) feet more or less along the said line of U. S.
