TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

That Mr. R. S. Burchett and Mary Burchett
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:

WHEREAS, we, the said R. S. Burchett and Mary Burchett
in and by our certain note or obligation, bearing date the 10th day of December 1926,

we are indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,
duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Six Hundred + no/100 (\$600.00) Dollars,
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 10th day of December A. D. 1926,

according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that
we the said R. S. Burchett and Mary Burchett shall pay or cause to be paid to the said
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of December
1926, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of \$10.00

\$6.00 Dollars, (\$6.00 Dollars,
being the regular monthly installment payable on the Six (6) Shares of Stock and \$4.00
Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the
sum of \$9.20 Dollars, (\$6.00

Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$3.20 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);
for the next twenty months the sum of \$8.40 Dollars, (\$6.00 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and \$2.40

Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$7.60
Dollars, (\$6.00 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and \$1.60
Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of \$6.80

Dollars, (\$6.00 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and 70.80 cents Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)
Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said Six (6)
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by us to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made we, the said
R. S. Burchett and Mary Burchett

and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against us by R. S. Burchett and
Mary Burchett in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the
said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being made to the same as they more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said R. S. Burchett and Mary Burchett
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me
the said R. S. Burchett and Mary Burchett

in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the sealing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

About two and one-half (2½) miles southeast of
Greenville, County Court House, in subdivision known
as Annex, said tract being known and des-
ignated as Lot No. 5 according to plat of W. D. Neves,
Engineer, March 1913, and recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C"
Page 101, and having the following metes and
bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake on the West
side of Bradley Street, 50 feet from corner of Earle
Drive, and running thence S. 64.30 W. 320 feet to
a stake, thence S. 24 W. 100 feet to a pin; thence N.
64-30, E. 320 feet to a pin on Bradley Street; thence
with said Street N 24 W. 100 feet to the beginning
Corner, and being the same lot of land convey-
ed to us by C. A. Turner by deed dated December
9th. 1926 to be recorded.
