TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We Flora C Bryson and Alice Bryson
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:
WHEREAS, *we* Flora C Bryson and Alice Bryson
in and by *our* are certain note or obligation, bearing date the 13th day of January 1927
are indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,
duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Fifteen hundred and 25/100 Dollars,
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 31st day of January A. D. 1927,
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that *we*
the said Flora C Bryson and Alice Bryson shall pay or cause to be paid to the said
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of January
1927, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty-five and 25/100
Dollars, (Fifteen and 25/100 Dollars,
being the regular monthly installment payable on the fifteen Shares of Stock, and ten and 25/100
Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the
sum of Twenty-three and 25/100 Dollars, (Fifteen and 25/100
Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and eight and 25/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);
for the next twenty months the sum of Twenty-one and 25/100 Dollars,
(Fifteen and 25/100 Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and six and 25/100
Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of Nineteen and 25/100
Dollars, (Fifteen and 25/100 Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and
four and 25/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the
sum of Seventeen and 25/100 Dollars, (Fifteen and 25/100 Dollars, being the
monthly payment on said shares of stock and two and 25/100 Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)
Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said fifteen
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by *us* to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made *us*, the said
Flora C Bryson and Alice Bryson and shall pay or cause to be paid all fines which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against *us* the said Flora C Bryson
and Alice Bryson in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations as in and by the
said note or obligation, and the conditions thereunder written, reference being thereunto and will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *we* the said Flora C Bryson and Alice Bryson
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and also in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to *us*
the said Flora C Bryson and Alice Bryson
in hand well and truly paid by the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, at and before the signing and delivery of these Presents, (the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

all that piece parcel or lot of land in Kristy Hill Township
County and State aforesaid, being a part of the sub-
division known as McCullough Heights and designated
as lot no. 28 as per plat of subdivision made by R. W.
Parker, in 1918 and recorded in the R. M. C. office
for said County in plat book C. at page 26 reference
to which is hereby made, said lot fronts Brook Street
60 feet and runs back in parallel lines 150 feet
bounded by said Brook Street, lot no. 26, lots no. 27 and
an alley - and being the same lot of land conveyed to
us by deed of Joseph A. McCullough dated June 23,
1922, recorded in the R. M. C. office aforesaid in
Deed Book 57 at page 56-1.
