TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Thomas Lomax
of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, and the State of South Carolina, send Greeting:
WHEREAS, I, the said Thomas Lomax
in and by my certain note or obligation, bearing date the 23rd day of April 1927
am indebted unto The Carolina Loan and Trust Company, of the City and County of Greenville, in said State (a body corporate,
duly incorporated under the laws of such State), in the sum of Fifteen hundred and fifty ^{no}/₁₀₀ Dollars,
with interest thereon at the rate of eight per centum per annum, payable monthly, from the 23rd day of April A. D. 1927,
according to the provisions of the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations of the said Company, in manner and form following, that is to say, that
the said Thomas Lomax shall pay or cause to be paid to the said
Company, or its certain attorneys, successors or assigns, at Greenville City aforesaid, monthly, on the 20th or before the end of the month of May
1927, and on the 20th or before the end of each month thereafter for twenty successive months, the sum of Twenty and ^{no}/₁₀₀
and ³⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, (Fifteen and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars,
being the regular monthly installment payable on the 15 1/2 Shares of Stock, and ten and ³³/₁₀₀
Dollars, being the monthly interest on the advance or loan) until there have been paid twenty monthly payments, and shall for the next twenty months pay the
sum of Twenty three and ⁷⁷/₁₀₀ Dollars, (fifteen and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀
Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and eight and ²⁷/₁₀₀ Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due);
for the next twenty months the sum of Twenty one and ⁴⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars,
(fifteen and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, being the regular monthly payment on said stock and six and ²⁰/₁₀₀
Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the sum of nineteen and ⁶³/₁₀₀
Dollars, (fifteen and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and
four and ¹³/₁₀₀ Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due); for the next twenty months pay the
sum of seventeen and ⁵⁷/₁₀₀ Dollars, (fifteen and ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, being the monthly payment on said shares of stock and two and ⁰⁷/₁₀₀
Dollars, being the monthly interest on balance due.)
Each of the above payments to be made on the 20th or before the last day of each month, and shall thereafter surrender to the Company the said 15 1/2
shares of stock and the certificate thereof, the amount at such time paid shares by me to be credited as a payment upon the advance or loan made me the said
Thomas Lomax
and shall pay or cause to be paid all fees which may be duly imposed upon, or charged against me the said
Thomas Lomax in accordance with the Charter, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations, as in and by the
said note or obligation, and the condition thereunder written, reference being thereunto had will fully appear.
NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Thomas Lomax
in consideration of the said sum of money as aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said The Carolina Loan and Trust Company,
according to the terms of said note or obligation, and in consideration of the further sum of Five Dollars to me
the said Thomas Lomax
do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The Carolina Loan and
Trust Company, all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:
